Who we are

What personal data we collect and why we collect it

We only collect information (name and email address) that you have sent us via email or payment form. This information is not shared nor used for marketing purposes outside of the organization. Email addresses and contact information may be shared between members of the organization, such as between the editor, contest administrator or classroom instructor. Contact information is secured on a computer or via Constant Contact, if you opted in to receive our email newsletters.

Cookies

Our website uses cookies so that we remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and location you are in. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies are used.

Google uses cookies to collect information about your visit, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about your browser, device, and your IP address. This means that when you visit another website, you may be shown advertising based on your browsing patterns on our website.

Embedded content from other websites

Articles on this site may include embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). These websites such as Youtube, Twitter, Facebook, or Instagram may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracking your interaction with the embedded content.

Analytics

We may store your IP address via Google analytics, but if you are logged into Google, your IP address is usually shielded.

Who we share your data with

We do not share your information with anyone outside of the organization.

How long we retain your data

If you leave a comment, the comment and its metadata are retained indefinitely. This is so we can recognize and approve any follow-up comments automatically instead of holding them in a moderation queue.

What rights you have over your data

You can request to receive the personal data we hold about you, including any data you have provided to us. You can also request that we erase any personal data we hold about you. This does not include any data we are obliged to keep for administrative, legal, or security purposes. You are welcome to opt out at any time from our email newsletters.

Where we send your data

Visitor comments may be checked through an automated spam detection service.
